

SJS - School Facility Needs Summary

The following is a high level summary of the existing classrooms and the new classroom and facility needs based on 2009/2010 enrollment of 340 and projected future enrollment of 400 students by 2011/2012. Discussions with the school board ad-hoc facilities committee suggest that the maximum enrollment the school can support is approximately 450 students – which assume two homeroom classrooms per grade in level PK3 - 8. The below described new classroom and facility needs contemplate providing appropriate space for 400-450 students.

Current Classrooms - 18 Total Classrooms Today

- ❖ 10 in primary building
- ❖ 6 in old building
- ❖ 1 on mezzanine
- ❖ 1 on lower level/cafeteria area

Total Number Classrooms and Space Requested by August, 2011/2012

- ❖ 4 additional classrooms needed for a total of 22 homeroom classrooms
 - (2) PK 3yr
 - (2) JK 4 yr
 - (10) total for Kindergarten - Grade 4
 - (8) total for Grades 5 - 8

Classrooms need to accommodate up to 25 students - as needed, can the current 18 classrooms be reconfigured to accommodate up to 25 students?

In addition to 22 homeroom classrooms the following additional space is requested

- ❖ 4 specials classrooms (all shared and utilized by grades K - 8)
 - Music/band
 - Art
 - Media Center (library and computer lab)
 - Language
- ❖ 1 small resource room for reading curriculum and any other potential resource subject
- ❖ Lunchroom to accommodate a minimum of 100 students
- ❖ Storage is minimal and the school and staff needs more storage, especially in each classroom
- ❖ Reception area at main door
- ❖ Administration office area
 - 2 offices for Principal and Asst Principal
 - 1 cubicle/open workspace area for Admin Support
 - Conference Room (staff mtgs, special educators, parents and other such private matters)
- ❖ Elevator in old building or an elevator and bridge for access to old building
- ❖ Facilities need to be handicap accessible to accommodate current students as well as new students
- ❖ Include existing building upgrades: windows, pipes, tuckpointing, etc.
