



CELEBRATING OUR 125TH ANNIVERSARY,

St. Josaphat Parish has been the church to come home to since 1883. With faith in a loving God, we joyfully welcome all who wish to come together as a community of shared faith in Jesus Christ, to give glory and praise to God. St. Josaphat Parish continues to grow as a welcoming Catholic community celebrating our spiritual growth in worship, committed to excellence in education, dedicated to serving others.

To strengthen and continue our mission, St. Josaphat Parish is embarking on a multi-phased campaign to raise \$5 million to:

- > **Build new school classrooms** and a media center combining a Library and Computer Lab to accommodate our growing enrollment (\$2 Million)
- > **Update the infrastructure** in both the primary and middle school buildings (\$1 Million)
- > **Repay the loan** received in 2008 to build new bathrooms in the lower parish hall and renovate classrooms and other spaces which created new classrooms (\$1 Million)
- > **Repair infrastructure** and perform maintenance in the church and rectory, including updating the facilities to make both structures safe and secure and to create additional parish meeting space (\$1 Million)



Blessed Today, Blessing Tomorrow: A Campaign for St. Josaphat Parish is being launched after a two year preparation process that began with our Strategic Plan. Our parish is flourishing and experiencing consistent growth. In order to make a Catholic education possible for the children already seeking enrollment in our school we need to build classrooms. Our Facilities Committee has identified infrastructure and necessary maintenance issues in all three of our campus buildings that are critical to their future use.

Blessed Today, Blessing Tomorrow: A Campaign for St. Josaphat Parish goes beyond brick and mortar. It is an investment in sharing our Catholic faith traditions with both young and old. We are blessed to be the recipients of great gifts from those who have come before us. SCHOOL

CONSTRUCTION/RENOVATION

Approximately \$2 million from our campaign will be used to build and remodel our current school facility by September 2011 in order to provide space for the growing number of children in our parish. In order to serve increased enrollment, our program includes the following:

- > Build additional classrooms to accommodate two homerooms for each grade PK3-8. In addition, we intend to accommodate our three- and four-year-old pre-school and kindergarten classrooms on the ground level of our facility.
- > Build a Media Center, combining a Library and Computer Lab to be used by all grades.
- > Evaluate design opportunities to include special fine and liberal arts classrooms for all students including Music/Band, Art and World Language.
- > In addition to the above, our renovation plans will include existing and new space to provide:
 - > An additional resource room for our primary students' reading curriculum
 - > A lunchroom to accommodate 100 students
 - > More storage space for our teachers
 - > A reception area at the main door
 - > Functional space for our Administrative Staff
 - > Conference room for staff meetings and private meetings with parents
 - > Handicap-accessible upgrades to allow access to all parts of the building

INFRASTRUCTURE

Approximately \$1 million from our campaign will allow us to do the following necessary infrastructure repairs to the school:

- > Tuckpoint the exterior of the middle school building
- > Complete the window restoration project in the primary school building
- > Replace and update plumbing to provide hot water throughout both buildings
- > Provide new, secure doors at the school entrance on Belden Avenue

INFRASTRUCTURE

Approximately \$400,000 from our campaign will be used to:

- > Add two handicap-accessible bathrooms
- > Refinish the pews
- > Repair the church towers
- > Replace the roof of the daily mass chapel (Sunday cry room)
- > Repair plaster and paint areas of the sacristy

RECTORY

INFRASTRUCTURE

Approximately \$600,000 from our campaign will be used to:

- > Tuckpoint the exterior of the building
- > Replace the dirt floor area in the basement with a concrete floor and repair existing damaged concrete areas
- > Complete the window restoration project
- > Replace and update plumbing to provide hot water throughout the building
- > Reconfigure the building to accommodate additional meeting space for the growing number of parish groups and committees

REPAYMENT OF INVESTMENT

Approximately \$1 million from our campaign will be used to repay our loan:

During the summer of 2008, we borrowed funds from the Archdiocese to complete \$1 million of necessary projects in the Parish. Our Campaign will allow us to repay this debt and continue on with the major building, renovation, and repair work we are planning. The projects completed last summer include:

- > New bathrooms in the lower Parish Hall
- > A new middle school classroom from the gym balcony/library
- > A new primary school classroom from the former computer lab
- > An updated middle school science lab
- > Renovation of the gym stage to provide for use as a music classroom
- > Repair and painting of the entire gym and stage
